PUBLIC SAFETY ADVISORY

To keep you informed:

Baltimore Police are investigating an armed robbery of a graduate student who was robbed at 2 am today inside of his apartment in the 300 blk. of E. University Parkway (between Guilford and Abell Avenues). The student had invited an individual he had met online to come to his residence and once inside, the suspect displayed a handgun and robbed him of his wallet and cellphone before leaving the apartment in an unknown direction. Baltimore Police responded and along with Campus Security canvassed the area with negative results. There were no injuries reported.

The suspect gave the name of Michael Wilson and is described as a black male, 22 years old, 6'0", thin build, 175 lbs., wearing a red shirt and blue jeans.

Campus Safety and Security would like all JHU affiliates to be aware of this incident and remind everyone should you find yourself the victim of a robbery, do not resist and do not pursue suspects. Always remember to stay calm, listen and observe intently, surrender any requested property and report the crime as soon as possible.
