## **PUBLIC SAFETY ADVISORY**

To keep you informed:

Since July 28th, there have been seven armed street robberies in the Charles Village area and the Oakenshawe area above University Parkway. In the two most recent incidents, the suspects involved in these robberies have been seen in a light colored, possibly silver, sedan.

The most recent robbery occurred today, Saturday, August 5th, at 4:25 p.m. Three students were walking in the 200 block of Chancery Road when two suspects exited a vehicle, walked up to the victims and suspect #2 pointed a handgun at the victims and demanded money and cell phones. A home owner who came out to investigate was also victimized and robbed by the third suspect. None of the victims reported any injuries. The suspects then returned to the vehicle and left the area.

The suspects were observed in a vehicle described as a light-colored Chrysler with a Maryland tag of 7CW5153.

The suspects' description in the most recent case are:

#1 - black male, dark complexion, teens to mid-twenties, little hair on the face, and one arm in a sling

#2 - black male, 5'3", very thin, short black hair, tattoos on neck and arms, wearing a black Jordan tee shirt and armed with a black handgun with a silver slide

#3 - black male, 5'8", very thin, black hair, wearing a red tee-shirt

Baltimore Police are actively investigating these robberies and Campus Safety and Security have deployed additional patrols in our area.

Campus Safety and Security would like all JHU affiliates to be aware of these incidents. and remind everyone to stay in well-traveled areas and walk with a friend or a group of friends when out and about.
