SUSPECTS DESCRIPTION:

Suspect #1: Male, juvenile, tall, wearing black clothing.

Suspect #2: Male, juvenile, wearing black clothing.

Baltimore Police are investigating a report of a commercial robbery which occurred at the 7 Eleven store. The store clerk advised two suspects approached the counter and threw a beverage on him. Suspect #1 reached into the register and removed cash. The suspects were last seen running east on 28th street. There were no physical injuries. Campus Safety and Security searched the area with negative results.

CRIME TIP: When entering a retail establishment, be aware of who is there and what is happening. Don't be distracted with a cell phone or listening to personal electronics. By then it is too late to make an effective escape in an event of a crime in progress.

Should you find yourself the victim of a robbery, do not resist and do not pursue suspects. Always remember to stay calm, listen and observe intently, surrender any requested property and report the crime as soon as possible.
